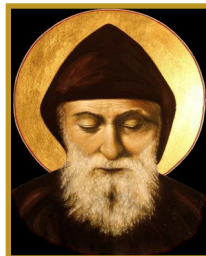

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dear Friends,

A word from Pope Francis ~

“We need a Church capable of walking at people’s side, of doing more than simply listening to them; a Church which accompanies them on their journey.”

Today we celebrate the first Sunday of the Holy Cross. Our Lord Jesus spoke many times to His followers about His Passion and Death, His Resurrection and His Glory at being seated now at the right hand of the Father. The two sons of Zebedee, Jacob, and John, asked the Lord to grant them to be seated in glory, one on His right and the other on His left, without mentioning His suffering and death. Then Jesus reminds them that the price of glory is to drink from the cup of His suffering. This first Sunday leads us into the season of the Holy Cross preparing us for whatever suffering and temptation we will face so we may remain filled with hope and rise with the Lord in His glorious Kingdom.

We welcome back all those who were able to spend the summer weekends away. In spite of the presence of the Coronavirus pandemic, a number of our parishioners were able to spend the summer weekends out of town. A friend of mine shared his experience with me as he said: When I was growing up, my family had a summer home on Delavan Lake in Wisconsin. Summer weekends and holidays were always spent “at the lake.” We were very familiar with the summer’s Mass schedule at both St. Andrew’s Church in Delavan and St. Benedict’s Church in Fontana. Both parishes became our summer parish as we would go to whichever church offered the next scheduled Sunday Mass. We would return to our home parish of St. John the Baptist in Winfield on the Sunday following Labor Day.

I was always amazed to learn what had happened at my home parish during that period that we were “at the lake” between Memorial Day and Labor Day. It was easy to lose touch with our home parish while we were at our summer parishes. If this experience sounds familiar, if you have been attending another parish “at the lake” this summer, we are very happy to welcome you back home. If your summer Mass attendance took a vacation during the summer months, we are also glad to have you back with us. Autumn and the start of the school year are a good time to recommit ourselves too faithfully joining with our parish community for Mass each weekend.

Thank you to our Knights of Columbus Council and the Men’s Club for hosting the Bon Fire on Friday, September 10th for members, parishioners and friends. This is the first year they have done this.

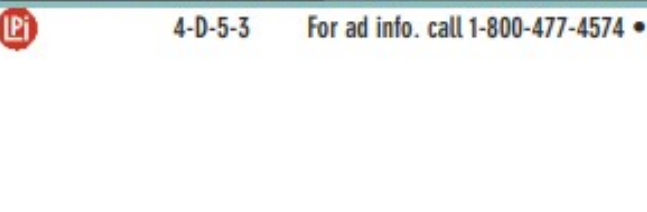
