Priesthood Sunday, September 26, 2021, is a special day set aside to honor priests in the United States. How wonderful that this is also the day that we are honoring our own pastor, Chorbishop Alfred Badawi, and his calling to the priesthood as he celebrates his 30 Year Ordination Anniversary!

Priesthood Sunday is a day to reflect upon and affirm the role of the priesthood in the life of the Church as an essential one.
