





Our non-profit, Urbi et Orbi Communications, the publisher of *Inside the Vatican* magazine, has a project, <u>Friends of Leba-</u> non and we work with Patriarch Rai and are in contact with Bishop Mansour in the United States. ABOUNA CHRIS' CORNER

15TH SUNDAY OF PENTECOST REPENTANCE OF A SINFUL WOMAN
