

#### LITURGICALLY SPEAKING

**TRIUMPH OF THE CROSS** - September 14th is the feast of the Triumph of the Cross. At first, the words "triumph" and "cross" seem contradictory. How can a cross, a symbol of shame, humiliation and punishment for wrongdoing, be tied to something or someone triumphant? Only when we make reference to Jesus Christ does the cross become triumphant: a symbol of faith, hope and love.

A SYMBOL OF FAITH: Of all the symbols we have of our faith, none is more powerful or says as much as the cross. It conjures up the image of Jesus Christ, who spent three years of public life proclaiming the Good News. This Good News says that people could be saved from their sins; that they could repent and be in God's good graces once again. The cross also reminds us of a rich heritage of faith Christianity has behind it: a rich history of men and women dedicated to serving God and because of their action, changing the course of history and continuing to influence our world today. Two people of the modern age who come to mind for me in this regard are Archbishop Oscar Romero and St. Mother Theresa.

A SYMBOL OF HOPE: Why is the cross a symbol of hope? Had Jesus run away and not died on the cross, all the good He did for those three years of public life could have been undone. How could He speak about eternal life and run away from death? He was not a hypocrite. He was one who stood behind His words. So Jesus must have believed in what He said and did those three years. That, in turn, helps us to see that His message was important to Him. If it were not important to Him, how could we be expected to make it important in our lives? The cross gives credibility to Jesus' Good News.

A SYMBOL OF LOVE: The message of Jesus was so important and He wanted so much for His followers to see its importance that He was willing to die for what He said and did during His public ministry. The message itself was one of total, selfless, unconditional love, a love stronger than death.

**SO WHY IS THE CROSS TRIUMPHANT?** I can think of three reasons. First of all, the cross is triumphant because Jesus rose from the dead. His death was not the end. Secondly, the cross is triumphant because there are still disciples taking up their cross following Jesus two thousand years later. Thirdly, the cross is triumphant because it reminds us that we too will have eternal life. We shall be triumphant over death


