AN INVITATION TO HOLY WEEK SERVICES

This Lenten season we have considered the theme: "Meeting Jesus! What will be your response?" One of the most sacred ways to meet our Lord and Savior comes from remembering and immersing ourselves in the journey towards the Cross!

Join us this Holy Week as we meet Jesus and answer the important question that comes to us on Easter Sunday morning: how do we respond to the grace and love that has been given to us?

Palm Sunday Services will be held on April 1st at 4:00 p.m. and April 2nd at 9:30 & 11:30 a.m. We celebrate Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem although it hauntingly points to His ultimate betrayal, trial, Crucifixion, and Death. Palm branch processions will be at all the services.

Holy Thursday Service... the Washing of Feet Ceremony is a solemn and beautiful service on April 6th at 7:00 p.m. This service which includes the Divine Mass, leads us to reflect on Jesus' Last Supper with His disciples. Here, gathering at the table and watching as Jesus kneels to wash the disciples' feet, we receive the absolution that was denied him on Ash Monday and the great commandment from Jesus that we love one another as He loved us.

Good Friday Services... Friday, April 7th at 11:00 a.m. Pre-Sanctified Mass (Signing of the Chalice). Here a special Prayer of Consecration is said over the chalice (wine) and the consecrated hosts are used from the Last Supper Mass. The Stations of the Cross as seen through Mary's Eyes will begin at noon.

The Burial of the Holy Cross Service will be held at 7:00 p.m.

We give thanks to our incredible St. Sharbel Choir Directors of Music Ministry: Aziz Charabati, Ray and Kristin Staroscik, organist, Youssef Osachi, Jessy Srour, Rita Yammine, and all the choir members, servers, ushers, and readers for sharing their talents in making this mournful service so blessed and beautiful.

Easter Services will celebrate our Lord's triumph over death by his Resurrection on Easter Saturday, April 8th at 4:00 p.m. Vigil Mass – Rite of Peace as well as the 12:00 a.m. Midnight Mass - Rite of Peace!

Resurrection Sunday, April 9th, we have services at 9:30 a.m. Mass – Rite of Peace and 11:30 a.m. Mass - Rite of Peace Processions will take place at each of the Masses.


